Team participates at swim meet

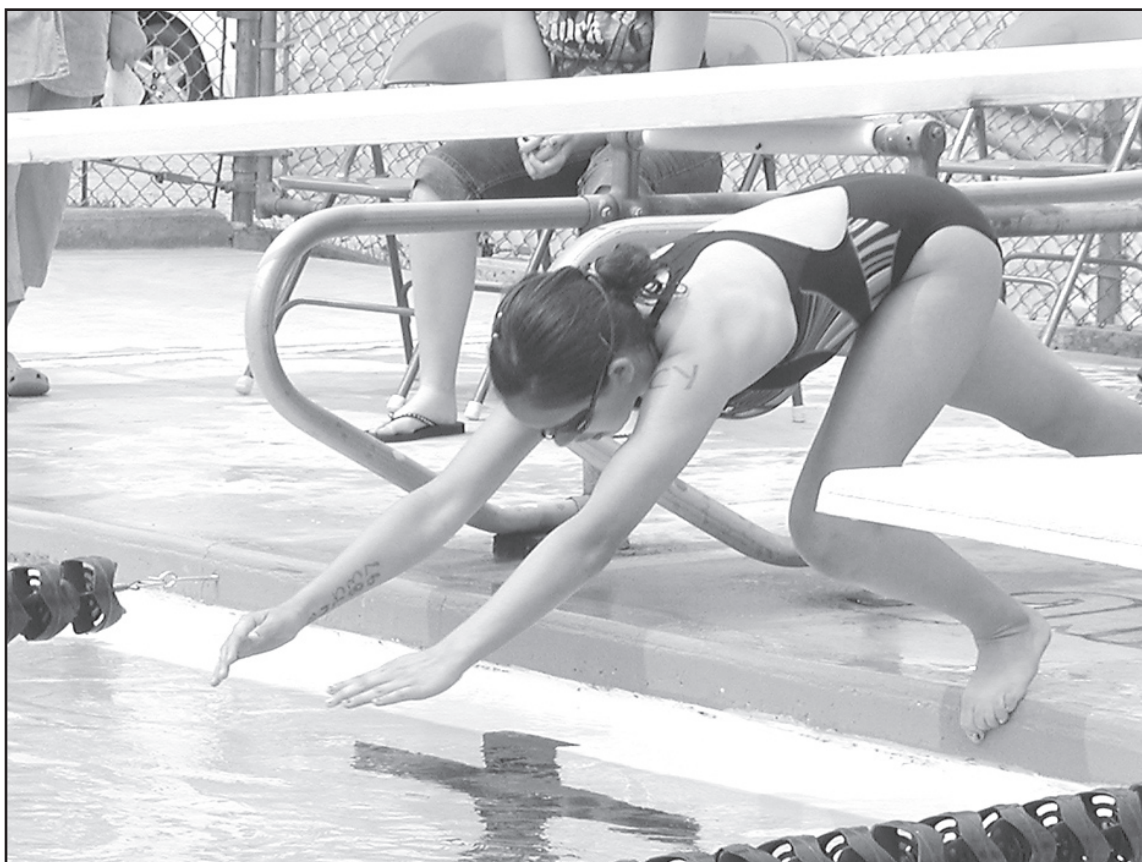
Four members of the Cheylin swim team participated in the Atwood swim meet on Saturday, June 11.

Tia Sager led the group with two first place finishes. With a time of 43.76, she placed first in the 19-and-over backstroke and first in the 19-and-over breaststroke with a time of 47.45.

Trent Howland was the youngest swimmer who attended from Cheylin. He swam in the 8-and-under division. He was disqualified in the breast stroke (he was 52.00), and he finished the short free in 43.24.

Diana Garcia participated in three events with two thirds and a fourth. She was third in the backstroke with a 51.10 and third in the breaststroke with a 53.03. Diana, who swims in the 11-12 age group, placed fourth in the short free with 43.1.

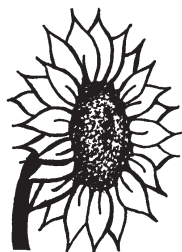
