The disc golf, also referred to as Frisbie golf, course was established about a year ago by Kary Zweygardt and his son, Jordan. The game is played much like traditional golf. Instead of balls and clubs, the players use a flying disc or Frisbie.

The object of golf is to complete each hold in the least number of strokes. In Frisbie golf, the player needs to put the disc in the basket in the lest amount of throws. The 9-hole course is a series of

baskets mounted on a pole. The disc is thrown from a tee area to the tar- Zweygardt.

The course has trees, shrubs and terrain changes which provides challenges for the player. When the disc lands in the basket, the hole is completed.

There are no green fees, players don't have to rent a cart and they never get stuck with a bad "tee

The roadside park, Mr. Zweygardt said, is better than most courses. There is not only rest room facilities, but there is a place for picnics and

Atwood has an 18-hole course, Goodland and Sharon Springs have nine-hole courses. In the future, Mr. Zweygardt is hoping to organize tournaments.

All ages, from the young to the elderly, can enjoy the sport. Not only is it a fun sport but it is good recreational exercise.
