Roy and Jeneva met at the farm of General George S. Patton called "Green Meadows" in August 2008 when they were attending the annual reunion of the 11th Armored Division. General Patton's daughter-in-law, Joanne Patton, had invited all the 11th Armored Division veterans and their guests to visit the farm which General Patton had bought near Boston, Mass., and where he

had planned to retire. The 11th division was a part of Patton's Third Army which fought at the Battle of the Bulge during World War II.

Jeneva's husband, Warren, was also a member of the 11th Armored Division and was wounded during the Battle of the Bulge for which he was awarded a "Purple Heart" and a Silver Star for gallantry in action.

Roy and Jeneva were married on the third anniversary of the day they met in Boston.

They will live part of the time in St. Francis and part of the time in Paducah where Roy was born and raised.

## Grade school to hold reading event

Thursday, Oct. 6, the St. Francis Elementary School will again participate in Jumpstart's, "Read for the Record." Jumpstart is a national organization formed to combat illiteracy in the United States. The past four years St. Francis has been part of the world record effort. Last year the total number reading on the event day was over two million people.

The program will begin at 8:40 a.m. in the St. Francis Elementary gym. Mr. Cassidy is the master of ceremonies for the program.

All the students are to wear red, as the title of this year's book is "Llama, Llama, Red Pajama." Scott Carmichael, principal, will talk about the importance of being a good reader and will then read

this year's story.

The program will begin with each sixth grade student speaking to the audience about their favorite book read while in grade school. They will tell a little bit about their book and why they especially liked the story.

A panel of teachers will select two boys and two girls that do the best job describing their book. The girls will cheer until half time with the varsity cheerleaders at a home football game and the boys will lead the team through the tunnel at the start of the game.

At the close of the program Mr. Kechter will take an all-school photo of the elementary students and staff. Parents and the public are invited to attend.
