

Signup time for farmers



To be eligible for commodities, the household's total monthly income must be below:

1,180 - household of one; \$1.594 – household of two: \$2.008 household of three; \$2,422 household of four; \$2,836 -household of five: \$3.663 - household of six; \$3,663 - household of seven; \$4,077 - household of eight. For each additional family member, add \$414.
