Signup time for farmers

Signup for the Supplemental Revenue Assistance Payments Program for 2010 crop losses will begin Monday, Nov. 14, and end June 1, says the U.S. Farm Service Agency.

Benefits are available to farmers and ranchers in counties with disaster declarations by the secretary of agriculture and adjacent counties who have suffered at least a 10 percent crop loss.

Farmers may also be eligible if

the actual production on their farm is half or less than normal, even if the farm is not included in a disaster declaration.

Operators should contact the agency's Decatur County office to begin the enrollment process after Nov. 14.

Due to budget cuts, the agency can no longer mail newsletters and other reminders by mail, said Diane Barrett, county executive director. To keep up with programs

and deadlines, farmers need to give the county office their e-mail addresses, she said.

A monthly newsletter will be sent out to those who give the agency an e-mail address. Farmers also may go to www.fsa.usda.gov/ks and then click on "Newsletters" in the left column, or stop by the office and pick up a copy.

\$1,180 - household of one; \$1,594 - household of two; \$2,008 - household of three; \$2,422 - household of four; \$2,836 - household of five; \$3,663 - household of six; \$4,077 - household of eight. For each additional family member, add \$414.

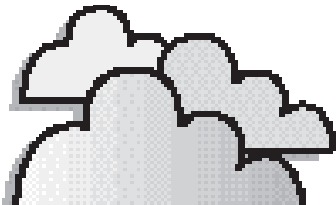
