Stripe rust has been found in trace levels in southern Scott County. This is the closest stripe rust to the Sunflower District.

Moderate temperatures and heavy dew in the morning are two components needed for infection of stripe rust.

place this week and can increase the risk for infection of stripe rust.

The final component is the stripe rust innoculum. Since the presence of disease continues to move closer, the risk is increasing.

Varieties with the Jagger based pedigree that have Yr17 are being affected by stripe rust.

Also, if stripe rust occurs in the wheat in our area, remember the flag leaf contributes over 75 percent of the nutrients for the filling of the wheat head.
