Farm agency announces important program updates

Agriculture's Farm Agency reminds producers that the American Taxpayer Relief Act of 2012 extended the authorization of the 2008 Farm Bill for many Commodity Credit Corporation commodity, disaster, and conservation programs through 2013.

The extended programs include, among others: The Direct and Counter-Cyclical Payment program, the Average Crop Revenue Election program, and the Milk Income Loss Contract program.

Farm Service Agency is preparing the following actions:

• Farm Service Agency will begin sign-ups for Direct and Counter-Cyclical Payment and Average Crop Revenue Election Program for the 2013 crops on Feb. 19.

• The Direct and Counter-Cyclical payment program signup will end on Aug. 2; the Average Crop Revenue Election program sign-up will end on June 3. The 2013 Direct and County-Cyclical and Average Crop Revenue Election programs provisions are unchanged from 2012, except that all eligible participants in 2013 may choose to enroll in either their choice made in 2012.
