Officers to target teen drivers for seatbelts

The Department of Transportation will be holding a two-week awareness seatbelt enforcement March 11 through March 22. Officers will be targeting teen drivers and their occupants.

In 2012, Kansas lost 43 teens in crashes with 74 percent of those teens not properly restrained with a seatbelt.

In an effort to increase seatbelt compliance, St. Francis officers were asked to target the area around their high school and any person not properly restrained. If

stopped, they will be issued a citation.

For over 20 years, law officers have tried various means to educate teens about the dangers of driving unbelted. They have learned that nothing impacts teen behavior more than vigorous enforcement. They have also learned that warnings have little or no impact on compliance.

People are urged to buckle up not only for the next two weeks but every time they get into their vehicle.

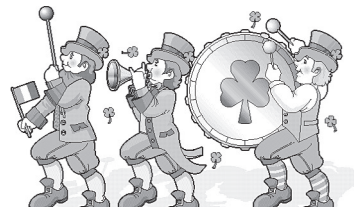
