Hispanic students receive scholarships

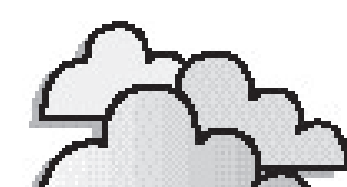
