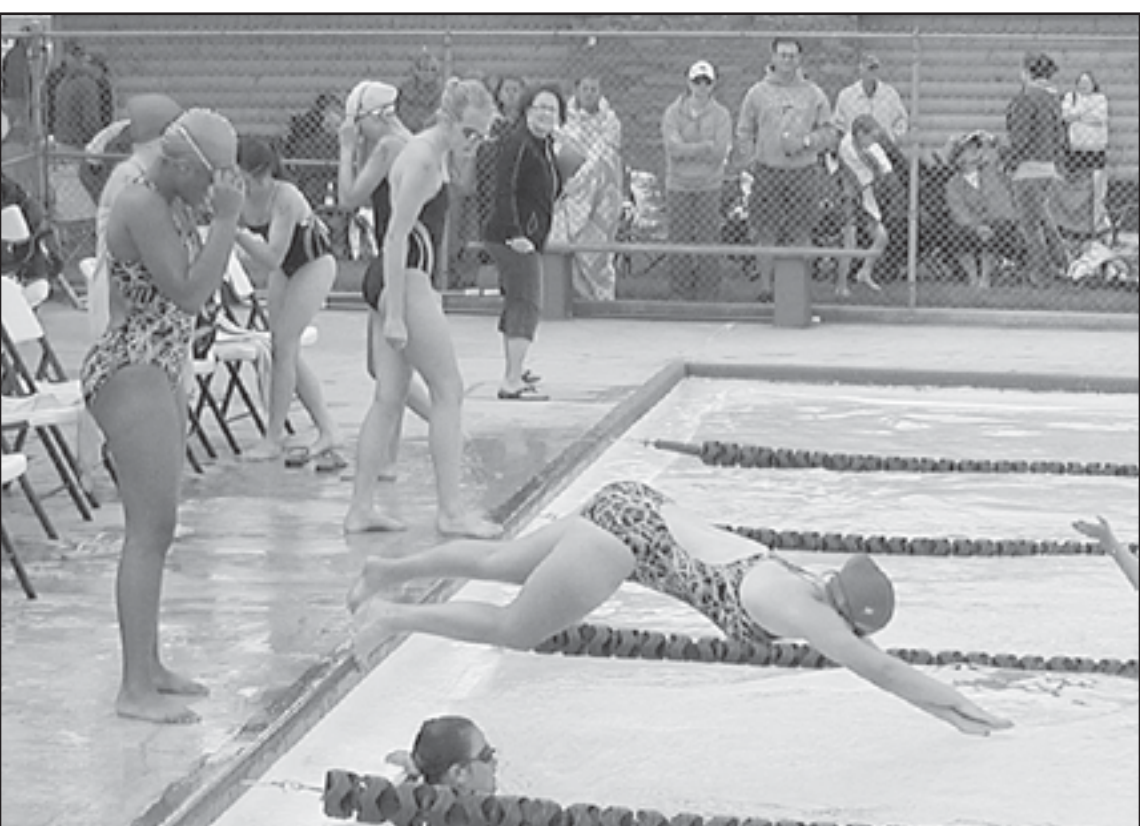
The pool was in great shape because of pool manager, AJ Marin, Coach Poling said. She had the guards on hand, not only to be guards, but help with all the other parts of the meet.
