

food establishments say that ground beef is to be cooked to an internal temperature of at least 155 degrees Fahrenheit. Proper cooking will destroy the E. Coli bacteria.

People should always wash their hands for at least 20 seconds with soap and warm running water before and after cooking and eating, and when leaving the rest room. 

Coli and are continuing to watch for cases in Kansas. Since January, there have been 11 confirmed cases of E. Coli reported in the state. One case has been linked to the recent national outbreak investigation of E. Coli related to eating recalled ground beef.

So, remember to wash your hand raw meats to any surface. Plates, and cook meat properly to stay healthy.
