ORDINANCE NO. 290  
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10-111 OF ARTICLE 1 OF CHAPTER X OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF BIRD CITY, KANSAS, ALLOWING FOR THE INCREASE IN MUNICIPAL COURT COSTS FOR TRAFFIC INFRACTIONS CASES. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BIRD CITY, KANSAS:  
SECTION 1: That Section 10-111 of Article 1 of Chapter X of the Code of the City of Bird City, Kansas, is amended as follows:  
10-111, COSTS. The Municipal Judge Shall have the power to assess costs for the administration of justice in the municipal court in ordinance traffic infraction cases in an amount not to exceed \$50.00 and in all other cases in an amount not to exceed \$50.00. Such Costs shall be in addition to witness fees and mileage as set forth in Kansas Statutes Annotated Section 12-4411.  
SECTION 2: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper.
