Seniors finish high school football career




high school football career at Stockton on Nov. 5 were seniors Chase Collier, Marcus Dodd, Brian Draper, Travis Hilt, Jus-


The season ended in Stockton when the Tigers defeated the Indians and advanced to Regional play.


