Birthday celebrated

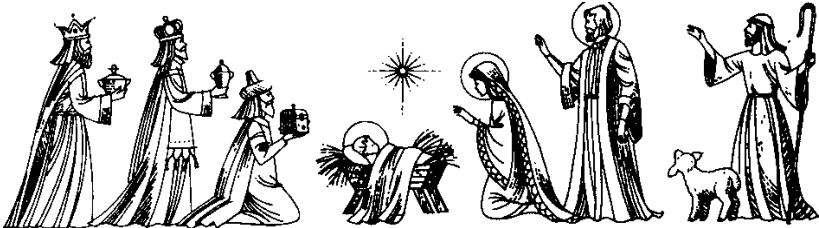
