# Escape to Black Hills the perfect get-a-way

Several people from this area enjoyed a Black Hills Get-a-Way tour last week to South Dakota, from Tuesday to Friday.

Some of the very interesting sights taken in were Mount Rushmore National Memorial, known as America's Shrine of Democracy and Crazy Horse Memorial, where the 88-foot high face of Crazy Horse has been completed and unveiled after 50-years of work. The start of the second 50 years is now underway. The tour group of 47 got to see a dynamite blast on the project while there.

Other sights enjoyed were a tour of the Badlands National park, an 1880 train ride in the hills, Black Hills Passion Play at Spearfish and a guided tour of Lead and Deadwood with

"Miss Sally" on board giving a very colorful talk on the area and its history.

Some of the group also visited the Adams House, which after her husband's death, Mrs. Adams had closed for 50 years, while time stood still, leaving everything intact. It was then restored and opened for tours by the city of Deadwood in 2000. The entire city of Deadwood is listed on the National Historic Register.

Stops were made both going and coming back at the Wall Drug in Wall, S.D. Wall Drug was made famous in the Dirty 30's by giving away free ice water, which it still does today.
