Talley Morrow to add teacher-aide in dramatics; Bruce Swihart, add assistant junior high wrestling coaching; and Kandee Raile, junior high volleyball coaching aide. David Morrow is the drama teacher; Steve Jenkins is head junior high wrestling coach; and Terri Orth is head junior high volleyball coach.

The board approved Vicki Killingsworth as the junior-senior high school custodian, taking the place of Dennis Merklin, who had resigned.

Mr. Werner said the paraprofessional position which had previously been filled by Lea Keller had been advertised. After discussing the position with Tammy Grice and Robin Burr, he advised not filling the position at this time. Both Mrs. Grice and Mrs. Burr felt the students would still be served well.

The administration is estimating there will be 20 kindergarten students and three transitional students this year. At this time, only a morning kindergarten class is being planned. The administration said there has been discussion of having all-day kindergarten but they did not plan on all-day classes. If there are more than the expected kindergarteners enrolled, it may be necessary to have a morning and an afternoon class. They would know more after enrollment on Thursday.

Managing drought talked about at Camp Lakeside

Marlene Moore, owner of Shamrock Ranch in Wallace, Neb., will discuss drought management at the western adult range school scheduled for Aug. 29-31, at Camp Lakeside, Scott Lake, north of Scott City.

"Shamrock is a third generation ranch consisting of 4,900 deeded acres and 2,500 acres of leased rangeland located in southwest Nebraska where the annual rainfall is 18 inches," said Duane Cheney, Western Prairie Resource Conservation and Development coordinator at Colby.

The Kansas Grazing Lands Coalition, Inc., and Western Prairie Resource Conservation and Development are hosting the adult range school with contributing sponsors including the Truax Company and the Kansas Chapter of the Society for Range Management.

Drought Management Strategies is the theme and topics will include technical, financial, landscape health issues as well as a good dose of rancher perspective. Presen-

tations will include the benefits of well-managed riparian areas in reducing the impacts of drought conditions. Instruction will be presented on the indicators used to conduct a simple stream visual assessment to determine how healthy your stream and its watershed are currently.

Instructors include the United States Department of Agriculture Natural Resources Conservation Service, Kansas State University range and grazing lands specialist and Kansas Grazing Lands Coalition staff.

Featured speakers will include several area ranchers including Carl Davis, Hill City area rancher, who will discuss the Conservation Security Program and how his operation management allows him to participate in Conservation Reserve Program.

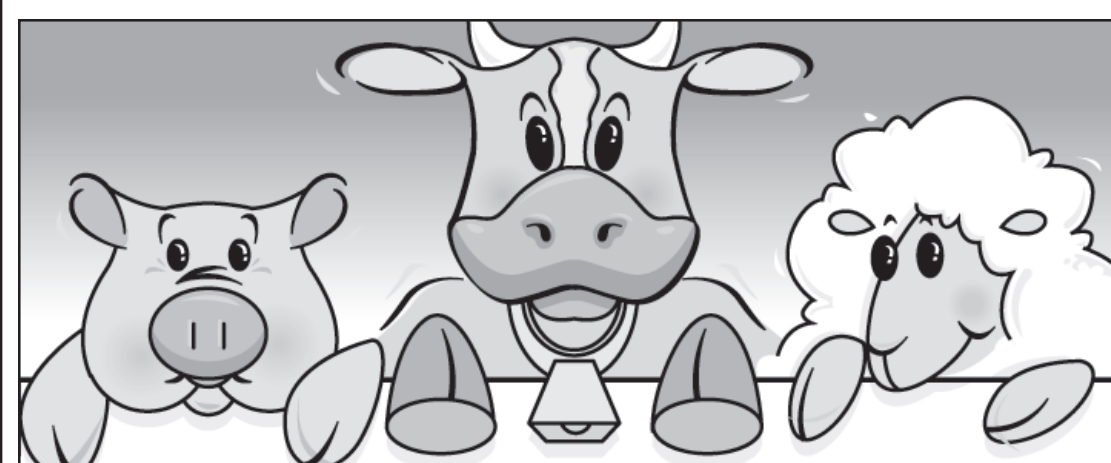
