"This is a big moment for Baylor golf," said Baylor Head Coach Tim Hobby. "This year's seniors were in my first recruiting class which makes this championship even more special."

Williams, a senior, won the individual title by eight strokes, shooting two-over par 72s in the first two rounds and a one-over par 71 in the final 18.

"This is just an awesome feeling and winning the title is exactly what we came here for," said Williams. "My chipping and putting is what really did it for me. I knew coming in that you had to have a good short game to play well
