Babe Ruth endures Hays sweep

There was good new and bad news on Sunday as the Hays Renegades swept the Colby Babe Ruth baseball team 9-7 and 17-6 at the Colby Recreation Fields.

The Renegades are one of the toughest teams the Colby team faces each year. The last meeting, in early June, resulted in a split. According to coach Jeff Kryczki, the 3-1 win in game two was the first in "4-5 years."

The good news in this series was that the Renegades were forced to play all seven innings in both games for the first time since June 14.

Josh Houtz took the loss in the first game, allowing two hits and two walks. Sean Mengel allowed a hit and three walks in relief. The Colby defense had three errors.

Offensively, Colby got hits from Houtz, with two singles, Tyler Knapp, a double, Brian Sulzman, an RBI triple, Chris Gordon, an RBI single and Bruce Arnberger, an RBI single.

Game three saw three Colby pitchers. Gordon started, followed by Arnberger in the top of the fifth and Sulzman in the top of the seventh.

Gordon left after allowing three runs on two hits, two strikeouts and three walks. Arnberger took the loss as Hays lit up for five runs and then got Sulzman for nine in the seventh. Colby had three errors.

Colby got offensive support from Houtz, who reached on an error and stole second on his way to scoring. Knapp, an RBI single, and a walk that scored, Sulzman, two singles, Gordon who reached on an error, driving in a run and scored off a single, Arnberger, who reached on an error that scored a run, stole third and scored off a single, Derek Elliott had a single and Mengel, who reached on an error.

Armstrong's chances hurt by teammates

BAR-LE-DUC, France (AP)—The chances of American Lance Armstrong winning the fifth stage of the Tour de France were hurt when two of his team's riders fell Thursday.

Australia's Stuart O'Grady kept the leader's yellow jersey for a third day when his squad won the stage, a team time-trial.

The American team slowed down for several minutes during the 41.61-mile stretch from Verdun to Bar-le-Duc after riders Roberto Heras and Christian Vandeveld fell. They got back on their bikes and caught up with the rest of the team, but the squad lost valuable time.

Still, the fourth-place finish behind the French team Credit Agricole, left Armstrong 15th overall.

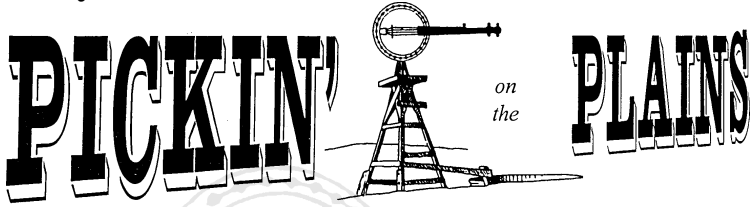
