PARIS (AP) — Lance Armstrong won his third straight Tour de France, ending three weeks of grueling competition with the Texan once again dominating the world's toughest cy-

In the leader's yellow jersey he has worn for the last seven stages of the Tour, Armstrong crossed the finish line on the Champs-Elysees with the main pack as tens of thousands of spectators lined the graceful avenue.

He became the first American to win the Tour three times in a row. Greg LeMond also won three Tours, but with a two-year gap between his first and second titles.

The Tour record of five wins is held jointly by four riders. Only Spain's Miguel Indurain won five consecu-

- In the early days of the race shopkeepers would stock their stores with food for the racers. It was considered an honor to serve the racers. 
