Trojans get magic 16th win at home

The Colby Community College Trojan basketball team snapped their longest losing streak of the season at four with a 77-68 win over defending Jayhawk Conference Champions Butler County at the Colby Community Building on Wednesday.

The Trojans were up 37-27 at half-time. Butler came out firing at the beginning of the second half and pulled within five once. They made a few more rallies, but never took the lead.

"I thought we really passed the ball well tonight and played great team basketball," said Trojan coach Brian Ostermann.

"It was very exciting to watch as a coach and I am sure it was also exciting to watch as a fan. We didn't break the attendance record, however, we were able to break the school record for wins during the Jayhawk era with 16. I am proud of our team for attaining that record and to do it at home was very nice."

A big plus for the Trojans was a season high 22 assists and just six turnovers. Colby also shot a season high 58.5 percent. Colby also broke the record for over-

all wins during their Jayhawk Conference era with 16, breaking the old record of 15 set last season.

Dedric Spooner had 16 points and three blocks. Joe Williams had 12 points. Pierre Tucker had 10 points. Billy Williams had eight points, seven rebounds and four assists. Eric Fowlkes had eight points and five assists. Keyon Williams had six points and six assists. Stuart Keltner and Mike Wolters had six points each. Brent Brooks had five.

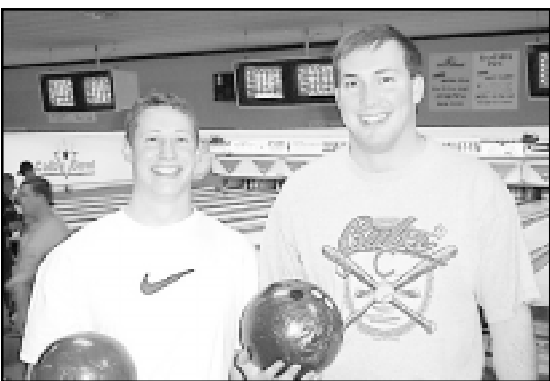
