The Detroit Red Wings and the Colorado Avalanche meet in Game 7 tonight — two great rivals playing for a spot in the Stanley Cup finals.

"We're looking forward to playing in a game of this magnitude,' Yzerman, the Detroit captain, said Thursday. "It's been a tremendous series and we're enjoying the competition that is bringing out the best in both

Stars — not thugs — have been the focus in the series, unlike the 1996 conference finals between Detroit and Colorado when the rivalry was ignited with plenty of punches and blood.

While some hard feelings carried over to regular-season games in the 1990s, the postseason matchups since 1996 have been relatively tame.

"I think people that have watched the series have appreciated the hockey that has been played," Detroit's Brendan Shanahan said. "I think a lot of people thought the rivalry was dead, but this series has shown otherwise.
