Announcement that three conserva-sociation, Kansas Department of Wild-tablishment of soil and water conser-other structure areas, livestock, or fields. Windbreaks should be a minimum of three years old.

Points to be considered in selecting award winners include windbreak design, management, location, density, and length.

The wildlife habitat award considers overall habitat quality, quantity and maintenance and a farm's overall impact on wildlife populations through use of conservation practices.

Nominations can be made by any person for one or all of the awards. Nominations should be made to the Thomas County Conservation District by Oct. 15 by either sending the nomination to 915 East Walnut in Colby or calling 462-7482, ext. 3.
