While you are visiting the library, be sure to check out some of these great new titles that have just arrived. *The Art of Deception* by Ridley Pearson is his latest thriller about Lou Boldt, Seattle police lieutenant, and Daphne Matthews, his forensic psychologist colleague who are investigating two cases that ultimately turn out to be one

and the same. Boldt is tracking a serial killer, and Matthews is investigating the death of a woman who was thrown from a bridge. The investigations begin to focus on the same subject, a stalker who haunts Seattle's legendary underground - created when the city was rebuilt after the great fire of 1889. *The Art of Deception* proves once again that Pearson is at the top of his game and a master of unpredictability.

If you are in the mood for a lighter mystery, check out Joanne Fluke's *Blue Berry Muffin Murder*. This is one of those cozies that includes seven original cookie and dessert recipes. The story has charming characters living in a quaint small-town, but the plot has lots of peaks and valleys to keep you guessing. Coffee shop/bakery owner Hannah Swensen is getting ready for the town's annual winter carnival by baking up a storm. Of course there is a murder, and wouldn't you know the victim apparently died from eating one of Hannah's prized blueberry muffins. Of course everything turns out all right in the end, so you

needn't worry about trying the recipe that is included. A warm treat would be just the right side dish for this tasty book.

A new author for me is Cassandra King. She is the wife of author Pat Conroy who wrote *Beach Music* and *Prince of Tides* and this is her debut novel. *The Sunday Wife* is the story of the Reverend Ben Lynch and his wife Dean who moved to Crystal Springs, to a wealthy Methodist community where Ben hopes to be launched up the ecclesiastical ladder.

Dean fears her low-class roots will fail him, but she plows right in doing all the things a minister's wife is expected to do in hopes of being accepted. When a friend begins to praise her remarkable musical ability, Dean realizes that she has her own dreams to follow which don't necessarily coincide with her husband's.

Tragedy strikes and all too soon *he Sunday Wife* has to decide what she truly believes.


