
# Hanzlick and Reist set January wedding date

DEARABBY: Of course, you make your living giving your know-everything advice to needy deficients, but that does not excuse your patronizing error.



Better for her to have said to her mother, "I love you," than rehash her childhood sexual abuse.

What do you know about what a woman has to do to maintain support for five children, and then, to justify her errors to herself? (And live with them.) Furthermore, do you have any assurance that harpooning the sick, elderly mother with the writer's ideas of "the truth" would result in "exorcizing" for either party? You have more responsibility to folk than that, even if that is "what you are there for."


