Hinrich, whom coach Roy Williams calls the best guard in the country, seemed to always be drawing a crowd during the Jayhawks' 81-57 victory against Holy Cross Tuesday night in the Preseason NIT.

He wound up with 13 points on 3-of-5 shooting, while Collison carried the load with 20 points and 8 rebounds.

The No. 2 Jayhawks (1-0) will host North Carolina-Greensboro Friday night in the tournament's second round.
