Jennings Czech Museum receives heritage grant

Heritage Associates of Jennings has received a grant for \$1,534 from the Kansas Humanities Council for the Czech Memorial Museum. The title of the project is "Establishing Best Practices at the Czech Memorial Museum in Jennings."

Project directors are Lila Jennings and Neoma Tacha of Jennings, who were assisted with the grant application by Decatur County Economic Development Director, Connie Grafel.

Consultant Mary Douglass of Salina spent two days last summer in Jennings, going over the application and suggesting a grant for which they could apply.

Three workshops will be presented at the museum in Jennings with the grant funds, the first scheduled at 9 a.m. on Thursday, Jan. 9. The topic will be "Conservation Practices."

All workshops are open to the public and area museum boards and curators in Hoxie, Colby, Norton, Oberlin and Logan are urged to attend. The other workshops are scheduled at 9 a.m. on Feb. 13, and March 13, at the same location.

In addition to information provided by the consultant, Heritage Associates plans to request a film on legal issues available through the Glasco Community Historical Society, which will be viewed at a separate monthly gathering of Jennings community volunteers and other historians prior to the second workshop in February.

The second consultant visit will focus on Cataloging/Indexing and Accession Records. The first full-day topic will focus on 3D artifacts. The topic to be addressed on March 13 will be "Archival."
