Butler County took an early lead, only to have Colby end the first half on a 24-10 run over an 11 minute span to lead by 9 at the break. The Trojans were hurt in the first

half by only converting 3 of 10 free throws, and they made just 14 of 29 for the game. Butler County never came within 5 points after half-time as Colby


would extend their lead to as many Colby held Butler County to 32.5% shooting in the 2nd half and







