

Trojan men drop another close one

For the second time in two games, the Colby Trojan men's basketball team lost a close game in the final seconds, coming up short against Cloud County 67-64 in front of nearly 1,000 people at the Colby Community building.

Colby lead by two at the break, but a see-saw game saw Trojan freshman Branden Miller hit a 3point basket and get fouled for a four-point play to give Colby a 64-63 lead with 34 seconds on the clock. On a scramble, Cloud County's Martin DeBoer drove to the paint, hit a lay-up, and a blocking foul was called. DeBoer sank the free throw to give Cloud County a 66-64 lead with 10.2 seconds left. Branden Miller drove the lane and found Mike Wolters spotted up for a baseline 3-pointer, but it rimmed margin. EJ Drayton scored 19 points, Justin Williams had 11 points, 14 rebounds, and 3 blocks, and Branden Miller scored 15
