The Colby Community College Endowment Association recently announced that Nick Wells has been hired as administrative director.

A graduate of Colby Community College and Panhandle State University, Wells will begin his duties Jan. 21.

"I am looking forward to returning to Colby," Wells said. "I served on the endowment Board when I taught at Colby College and am pleased to have the opportunity to work for the association."

Prior to accepting the job as administrative director, Wells was director of student services at Nebraska College of Technical Agriculture in Curtis.

He also owned Wells Marketing

Services (marketing purebred cattle services).

Wells is a familiar name on the Colby College campus.

In addition to teaching, he was the livestock judging coach for 18 years. During his tenure at Colby College, Wells had two national championship teams and a number of teams which reached the finals.

The Colby College Endowment Association, chartered on Nov. 17, 1964, has been invaluable to the growth and development of Colby Community College.

Not only has the organization raised thousands of dollars for scholarships, it has also been helpful in assisting the college Board of Trustees with the construction of build-


