Trojan men upset Seward County on the road

Colby gets first-everwin in Liberal

Colby Free Press The Colby Trojan men's basketball team beat Seward County in overtime Wednesday night in Liberal, 80-78.

Down 13 at the half-time, Colby stormed back to close within 3 at the 10-minute mark, and from there it was a see-saw game.

Colby missed an attempt with 37 seconds left in regulation, before Seward County missed an opportunity to win it in regulation.

The Trojans never trailed in overtime as they built a 5-point margin, only to have Seward County come back and tie the game at 78.

Colby's Eric Fowlkes drove the lane and hit a 10-foot pull-up with 13.7 seconds remaining for the game winning shot.

Seward's attempt at the basket was blocked by Justin Williams and Williams was able to snare the rebound.

This marks the first ever victory for Colby at Seward County, and Coach Ostermann is now 5-1 in overtime games at Colby.


In their last 6 games versus ranked opponents, the Trojans are now 4-2.

Colby ended Seward County's 33-game home court winning streak, and Colby beats its highest ranked team ever on the road.

EJ Drayton had 24 points, 9 rebounds, Eric Fowlkes 14 points, 5 assists, Justin Williams 11 points, 16 rebounds, 4 blocks, Joseph Williams 15 points (season high), and Branden Miller had 13 points, 4 rebounds, 4 assists.

The Trojans outrebounded Seward County 42-37, but turned the ball over 22 times (14 in the first half).

Colby will face it's third straight ranked opponent this week as #19 Hutchinson comes to Colby Saturday. Colby is now 14-5 overall and 2-3 in Jayhawk West play.
