"Raise less corn and more hell!" Mary Elizabeth Lease shouted to the thousands of Kansas farmers in the crowd, who were suffering from low crop prices and high shipping costs. They were ready to listen to her message about corrupt government and greedy railroad tycoons.

Mary's interest in workers' rights led to her membership in the Union Labor Party in Wichita. She worked for the Kansas Farmers' Alliance, formed to improve the economic status of farmers. Her enemies called her the "Kansas Python."

Many farm and factory workers joined the Populist Party to run their own candidates for office. Lease was a big hit at the rallies. In 1890, she made 161 speeches in Kansas alone. As a result, Kansas elected independent candidates for Con-
