Recyclable plastics include beverage bottles, rigid food containers for margarine, yogurt & ketchup.

♦ Plastics don't break down in the landfill.

♦ Most plastic containers wear a number on their bottoms. Flip it over - pay attention - only SOME plastics can be recycled.

♦ Look for the Moblus loop symbol, known internationally as a symbol for recycling. It has a specific number from 1-12.

♦ Coding on the plastic containers is important because most plastic recyclers recycle various plastics separately.
