

Colby Lady Eagle softball picks up two wins in Holcomb

Although rain in Colby postponed many athletic events on Thursday, the Colby varsity softball, played in Holcomb and the weather was on their side.

The games were shortened to five innings and the Lady Eagles brought home two wins, 14-4 and 20-3.

Coach Jack Elliott said the team has been battling sickness and injuries, but was pleased with the performance of the team.

"They have been hitting the ball extremely well," he said. "We still need to solidify the defense, but in all, it was a super day."

Junior Whitney Adams pitched both games for the team with a fifth inning relief from Cierra Rous in the second game.

In game one, Adams allowed only 4 hits, 4 runs and 3 walks. She



gave up no earned runs and struck out three batters. The Colby defense had 3 errors behind Adams in the field.

Offensively, the girls hit well and had five home-runs during the game, two by junior Savannah Rupp and one apiece by senior Samantha Wolf and juniors Shawna Cox and Jenny Hutfles. Crystal Herschberger and Alicia Leavitt both hit doubles.

At bat, Herschberger was 4-4, while Rupp and Wolf were both 3-

4. Rupp also had 4 RBIs while Wolf had 3. Adams was 2-4 and Leavitt and Becky Herl were 2-3. Leavitt was also credited with an RBI while Herl had 2. Hutfles was 1-3 with 2 RBIs and Cox finished the day 1-2 with 1 RBI.

In the second game, Adams allowed 3 hits, 3 runs and 1 hit batter. She gave up no earned runs or walks and was able to throw 3 strike-outs. Rous pitched a perfect fifth inning for the save. The Lady Eagle defense committed two errors.

Offensively, Wolf was 3-3 which included a home-run and a double. She had a whopping 7 RBIs. Rupp was 4-5 at bat and had a triple and 6 RBIs. Adams hit 3-4 with 2 double and 3 RBIs. Rounding out the offense was Herschberger, 3-5 and 1 RBI; Jen Wilson 1-3; Leavitt 1-3; and Brianna Swafford 2-2. Swafford hit one triple and had 2 RBIs.

Eagle baseball defeats Russell

Senior Jared Cranston pitched the first game and picked up his third win of the season. He allowed 3 hits, 2 walks and gave up no runs. Cranston struck-out 8 batters.

Sophomore Matt Augustine hit his second home-run of the season.

Bruce Arnberger and Brian Sulzman also had a homer each.

Those credited with RBIs were: Sulzman 4, Arnberger 2, Cody Hatfield 3, John Wark 2, Augustine 3, Cranston 1, Ryan Arensdorf 1, and Chris Gordon 1.

In game two, Augustine was at the mound for Colby. The 18-2 win was his second this season. He allowed 2 hits, 2 runs, 2 earned runs and walked 3. He was able to throw

4 strike-outs.

Offensively, Arensdorf and Hatfield had 4 and 3 RBIs respectively. Gordon had 2, while Josh Houtz and Augustine had 1 each. The only homerun of the game was by Arensdorf.

After a postponement of Thursday's game due to rain, the Eagles will again be in action on Thursday as they travel to Lakin for a 4 p.m. game.


