10 Things YOU Can Do



1

Turn a plastic milk jug upside down, cut bottom off and use as a funnel. Use the bottom of the jug as a saucer to put under plant pots.

2

At the store, ask yourself these questions: can this product or its packaging be reused or recycled? Was it produced from recycled materials? Whenever possible, choose products that meet these criteria.

3

Take a bag, basket or box with you when you shop.

4

Maintain and repair clothes, toys, tools and appliances rather than replacing them with new ones. Donate your old clothing, giving it new life for people who need it.

5

Save and reuse household items, such as string, plastic and glass containers, gift-wrap, seasonal decorations and shopping bags.

6

Use recycled or refurbished items such as printer cartridges.

7

Share newspapers and magazines with others.

8

Dispose of potentially hazardous materials such as motor oil, batteries and tires at appropriate locations.

9

Build a compost pile in your yard to convert biodegradable materials including grass and leaves into useful soil amendments.

10

Collect your aluminum and steel cans, then drop them off at their appropriate recycling center in your area.
