The Colby Eagle golf team picked up another tournament win on Saturday in Oberlin as they defeated the number two team, Atwood, by 16 strokes.

Again, as it was at the Colby Invitational, due to the weather, the boys only played nine holes.

Three Colby golfers led the medalists. Jared Helin, Dason Wente and Deni Wieland took first, second and third respectively. Helin finished the nine holes with a score of 38, while Wente shot a 40 and Wieland finished with 41.

Also placing in the top ten were Derek Elliott at sixth place with a score of 43 and Christopher Finley in ninth with 44.

Sean Mengel was the only Eagle to not place but came in close be-

hind with 49 strokes.

"The guys were very excited about how well things worked out," said coach Ray Higley.

"The trend over the last four tournaments tell me that the team is improving. We just need to stay focused as we head into post season play, and we should be in the hunt for a berth in the state tournament," he said.
