Louise Morrison

Louise Morrison, a former Colby resident, 95, died Wednesday May 14, 2003, in Minneapolis, Minn. Services will be held at St. Mark's Episcopal Cathedral in Minneapolis on Saturday.

Mrs. Morrison is survived by her son, Fred of Minneapolis and four grandsons. She was preceded in death by her husband Earl.

She was born in Canton Kansas in 1908 and attended high school in Manhattan and also Kansas State College, as it was known then. In 1934 she married her husband Earl Morrison and they moved to Levant. In 1936 the couple moved to Salina where she was a teacher in

the school system, but returned to Colby in 1953.

Mrs. Morrison lived in Colby from 1953 to 1970 and from 1953 to 1960 she was a member of the Colby elementary and high school boards serving as president for several years. She was also one of the textbook commissioner for the State of Kansas, selecting the textbooks that would be used in the public schools throughout the state.

After retirement, the Morrisons lived in Springdale, Ark., but then moved to Minneapolis 20 years ago to be close to family.

Service arrangements are being handled by Cremation Society of Minnesota in Minneapolis.
