

A RESOLUTION ENDORSING TRANS-PORTATION IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE CITY OF REXFORD, KANSAS AND THE ENACTMENT BY THE KANSAS LEGISLATURE OF A NEW STATE-WIDE COMPREHENSIVE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM

WHEREAS, one of the major responsibilities of City government is to plan for the immediate and long-term transportation needs

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Rexford, Kansas (hereinafter the "City") has conducted the necessary investigations to identify the transportation capital improvements that are needed in the City; and

WHEREAS, these specific transportation capital health, safety and welfare of its citizens in the future; and improvements are

WHEREAS, these specific transportation capital improvements are vital to the economic well-being of the City and to its long-

WHEREAS, the failure to undertake these transportation capital improvements will impede and may prevent the economic needs and goals of the City from being accom-

WHEREAS, the City is unable to finance such capital transportation improvements without substantial assistance from the State of Kansas and the Department of Transportation and other state government entities;

WHEREAS, the State of Kansas and the Department of Transportation and other state government entities cannot sufficiently address the transportation needs of the City and other cities and counties across the state without the enactment of a new Comprehensive Transportation Program by the Kansas Legislature.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXFORD, KANSAS:

Section 1. Priority Transportation Projets. After careful investigation of the transportation needs in the City, the following transportation capital improvements are hereby declared to be vital to the future economic growth and development of the city and the safety of its citizens

1) Improvements to U.S. Highway 83 making it four (4) lanes in width.

Section 2. New Comprehensive Transportation Program. The City hereby endorses and supports the enactment of a new Comprehensive Transportation Program by the Kansas Legislature of sufficient size and magnitude to address the specific transportation capital improvements set forth in Section 1.


