## K.U. coach looking for big improvement

LAWRENCE (AP) — Year No. 2 of the Mark Mangino era starts Saturday night when Kansas plays host to a seasoned Northwestern team that has hopes of returning to the top of the Big Ten.

After going 2-10 his first season, Mangino believes there's reason to hope for significant improvement. For one thing, an influx of junior college transfers will provide new faces, if not new results, at many

"You are always excited about your first game, but I don't think that at this point in our program any one game will make us or break us," Mangino said.

"We have a system in place now and we know more about our team and our ability. Our kids have had a tremendous training camp and I'm looking forward to playing this game. It's been a long wait to get to

Back to guide the offense will be quarterback senior Whittemore, one of the few bright spots last year for a team that was 0-8 in the Big 12.

Despite missing time with injuries, Whittemore threw for 1,666 yards and eleven touchdowns while running for 549 yards and another 11 scores. Also back is running back Clark Green, who averaged almost 68 yards per game last season despite a ragged offensive line. But the line has been rebuilt in large part.

Northwestern defense figures to be bolstered by the return of linebacker Pat Durr. The third-leading tackler in 2001 with 103 tackles, Durr sustained a major knee injury and missed most of last season.

It will be a seasoned offense the Jayhawks face. Key starters returning include quarterback Brett Basanez and versatile running back Jason Wright.
