Lady Trojans open with big win

The Colby Community College Lady Trojans basketball team opened the season in fine fashion Thursday afternoon defeating Yavapai (Ariz.) 76-55 in the South Plains Classic at Levelland, Texas.. Colby built a 44-22 lead at the break and coasted to the 19-point victory.

Bojana Samardziska led Colby with 19 points and 9 rebounds. Louise McLean had 15 points, 5 assists and 4 rebounds. van Dramac and Jenea Spiric each added 14 points in the Lady Trojan victory. Dramac also added 10 rebounds.

The Lady Trojans out-rebounded Yavapai 48-36 and shot 18 of 23

from the free throw line.

Colby returned to action today in the South Plains Classic vs. Northern Oklahoma (Tonkaka, Okla.) this morning and at 5 p.m. Saturday they will go up against Crowder College (Neosho, Mo.).

They will open their home season in the S&T Communications Ambassador Classic in the Colby Community Building on Thursday, Nov. 13

Tip-off for this all important game is 6 p.m.

Eighth volleyball ends year vs. Oberlin

The Colby Middle School 8th grade volleyball team took on Oberlin, there, on Oct. 16 in their season finale.

The Eagles fell behind early in the first game 5-3 and 14-9 as Oberlin out-hustled the Eagles. Colby went on a run behind two big hits from Leah Cox to bring the score within one at 14-15. But that would be as close as the Eagles would get. An aggressive Oberlin team continued their fast paced game and won the game, 25-20.

Game two was different as a desperate Eagle team rallied to take an early lead 8-6 off a kill shot by Tasha Wagoner. Becca Theimer was able to serve the Eagles to an 11-7 lead hitting three straight unreturnable balls. She was 11 of 14 behind the line for the night. When Darci Brown blocked a left side hit from Oberlin, the Eagles jumped up to a six-point lead at 15-9. That would prove to be the turning point for the Eagles as Lindsay Frahm took the ball and served three straight points to a lead of 18-11. Colby finished off Oberlin 25-19 as Logan Wark served two unreturnable balls.

Game three was a tight, hard fought battle until the Eagles jumped out to an 8-3 lead behind Wark serving four straight points, 10-12 for the night. Wagoner put down another kill shot after an outstanding set from Paige Stephens and the Eagles moved within four of the win at 11-7. Theimer served the Eagles to 13-8 but Oberlin wasn't done and tied the score at 13-13. A long rally ended with a hit from Wark and a 14-13 lead. Wagoner served Colby to the victory and was six-of-six for the night.

"Oberlin was a fine coached team," said Colby coach Dustin Rorabaugh. "This was a great victory for the girls in a tough atmosphere."

The B-game was just a two-game affair with Oberlin winning the first, 25-21 and Colby winning the second, 25-20.

"It was unfortunate that we couldn't have played a third game and our girls were really disappointed," Rorabaugh said, "but that's how they play their B games."

Liz Barnes and Jenny Dickman led the Eagles offensively serving 8-of-11 and 8-of-9 for the night. Barnes hit six straight points in the first game to bring Colby to within one at 16-17, but that would be it as Oberlin went on to win.

In game two the Eagles played much better and jumped on Oberlin 7-2, behind Kelly Gerstner serving five straight, two aces, and 9-of-10
