**Charles M. "Mose" Miller**  
Charles M. "Mose" Miller, 92, of Scottsdale, Ariz., died Monday, Feb. 2, 2004 at his home in Scottsdale.

Services were held on Wednesday, Feb. 4, 2004 at Mountain View Mortuary Chapel in Mesa, Ariz. and interment followed at Mountain View Memorial Gardens. He was born Aug. 20, 1911 in Colby and graduated with honors from Colby Community High School in 1930.

He was a WWII veteran reaching the rank of captain in the U.S. Army. He retired as president and chairman of the board of Farmers and Merchants State Bank in 1974 after serving 45 years.

His ultimate banking achievement was being elected to the board of directors of the Federal Reserve

Bank of Kansas City from 1968-1973. After retiring from the bank, he and his wife Arlien retired in Mesa, Ariz.

He was a member of the John Calvin United Presbyterian Church, the American Legion, St. Thomas A.F. and A.M. Lodge and Isis Temple.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Arlien J. Miller in October of 1991; his parents Ed and Birdie Miller; his brother Harree Hayden Miller in 1991; and his nephew Harree John Miller in 1960.

Mr. Miller is survived by a daughter, Jean Ann LoPorto of Scottsdale, Ariz.; two nephews, Alvin M. "Butch" Miller of Wamego and Jarree E. Miller of Wichita; and a niece, Marlene M. Carpenter of Colby.

Can you believe that Valentine's Day is Saturday? Once again, the days are sailing by at record speed. Of course Valentine's Day means a sweetheart of a deal for all you book lovers as it is the time we hold our annual Book Lover's Book Sale.

This year the book sale will be held here at the library on Saturday, beginning at 9 a.m. and ending at 3 p.m. As usual, book lovers will find something for everyone on their "honey" list from the hundreds of used books available for sale.

Besides books, there will be some videos, audio tapes, encyclopedia sets and other miscellaneous items. Prices begin as low as 10 cents and all profits go to the library.

Speaking of some great deals, here are a few books you might want to try reading on these cold winter nights. *I Don't Know How She Does It* by Allison Pearson will appeal to every woman trying to strike that impossible balance between work and home, and pretend-

ing she has everything under control - and for every woman who has wanted to slug the well-meaning person who coos, "Honestly, I just don't know how you do it." Meet Kate Reddy, hedge-fund manager and mother of two.

She can juggle nine different currencies in nine different time zones and get herself and two children washed, dressed and out of the house in half an hour. In Kate's life everything goes perfect as long as everything goes perfect.

*I Don't Know How She Does It* is a novel that is both funny and sad. If you are a Covington farmhouse fan (*The Ladies of Covington Send Their Love, From the Heart of Covington and The Gardens of Covington*) you will be glad to know that Joan Medlicott has a new one in the series called *The Spirit of Covington*.

The Ladies of Covington, Hannah, Grace and Amelia, are strong, wonderful sixty-something women filled with generous hearts and a hearty dose of practicality. In this story we find them devastated when a fire destroys their beloved old farmhouse on Cove Road. As they begin the long difficult process of rebuilding, they find an unexpected

silver lining as the crisis creates deeper bonds with the locals in their adopted North Carolina town. *The Spirit of Covington* is a perfect February read.

Finally, if you mix history with Valentine's Day you might come up with something like this next book. *The Lady and the Unicorn* by Tracy Chevalier (author of *Girl With A Pearl Earring*) is a luminous tale about a set of medieval tapestries known as the Lady and the Unicorn

sequence. A handsome artist is summoned to the home of a nobleman who wants him to design a series of battle tapestries.

The wife persuades the artist to talk her husband into a softer subject: the beguilement of a unicorn by a noblewoman. Chevalier meticulously describes the complex process of creating a tapestry and in the process the reader finds a romantic, beautiful story. How's that for a Valentine's Day read?
