

# Trojan men hang on for win over Seward

The #13-ranked Colby Community College Trojans built a couple first half leads of nine, but were never able to pull away from Seward County, but did manage a 73-70 triumph at Liberal Wednesday night.

Colby led 40-36 and were never able to shake the Saints as Seward County hit 13 three's and held a couple brief leads in the second half.

# Trojan ladies lose to Seward in overtime

The Colby Community College Lady Trojans had another epic battle with Seward County Wednesday night that resulted in the second overtime game in as many games between the teams. The #5-ranked Seward County Saints defeated the #8-ranked Colby Trojans 85-77 holding on to their 133-game home winning streak.

Colby came out storming building an 8-point first half lead behind 52 percent shooting in the opening frame. Colby maintained the lead a majority of the first half before Seward County rallied to tie the game at 32 at the break.

The Trojans again built a lead in the second half by as many as 11

Ontario McKee's two free throws with 7 seconds left sealed the Trojan victory while Justin Williams inspired play in the second half sparked the Trojans to their 22nd win.

The Trojans had one of their worst shooting performances of the season hitting only 42 percent. Colby outrebounded Seward County 43-39 and committed just

(50-39), however, foul trouble caught up with Colby. Jelena Spiric and Bojana Samardziska both fouled out and the Lady Saints were able to make their way back to hold a two-point lead with one minute remaining.

After a Colby time-out, All-America candidate Louise McLean connected on her sixth three-point shot to give Colby a 69-68 lead with 37 seconds on the clock.

Seward County was able to get the ball inside once again and Margaret DeCiman got fouled. DeCiman hit one of two free throws to tie the game at 69 with 11.7 seconds left. After breaking the Seward County press, Colby's Ivana

Drmanac missed a three-point shot with 2 seconds left and the Lady Saints and the Lady Trojans were headed into their second overtime game. The Saints proceeded to outscore Colby 16-8 in the overtime frame.

The Trojans were led by Samardziska's 21-point effort. McLean had 20 points, 9 rebounds and 7 assists. Drmanac and Spiric

added 8 rebounds.

The win marked the second straight victory for the Trojans in Liberal and Colby has now won five of the past six meetings between the two Jayhawk West rivals.

Colby is now 22-4 overall and 8-4 in Jayhawk West Conference action. They play at Great Bend Saturday to face #20-ranked Barton County. Game time is set for 8 pm.
