National event looks at ethnic diversity, immigration

Garden City Community College will host its 2004 Five-State Multicultural Conference on Thursday and Friday, March 25 and 26.

Participants from around the country will have the chance to learn how southwest Kansas deals with ethnic diversity and immigration.

Organizers have booked four keynote speakers for the event and

they are also organizing a series for breakout sessions by local presenters focusing on immigration-related concerns in health care, education and business.

"The 2004 conference will benefit professionals who work in multicultural settings in both the public and private sectors," said Anna Worden of Garden City Community College, one of the organiz-

ers. The conference has taken place annually in Garden City because the community's beefpacking industry has drawn extensive immigrant labor from Mexico, Central America and Southeast Asia for more than two decades, creating a unique cultural mix.

Dr. Donald Stull, a University of Kansas anthropologist, has labeled Garden City a window to the future

of rural and small town America. Breakout session presenters focusing on minority business development will include Gilbert Cruz, operator of Fiesta Courtyard in Garden City; Gilberto Dorantes of Commerce Bank and representatives of a multicultural task force affiliated with the Garden City Area Chamber of Commerce.

Presenters addressing immigrant and minority health care issues will be on hand from Kansas Social and Rehabilitation Services and the Garden City-based Mexican-American Ministries clinic.

In education, discussion and presentations are to be led by early childhood educators concerned about the need to give immigrant children the skills necessary to succeed in school.

There will also be a presentation by Melinda Lewis of El Centro in Kansas City, an organization that works to eliminate out-of-state tuition charges for undocumented students enrolling in Kansas colleges and universities.
