“My brother, Carl, was a victim of alleged physical abuse while in care of a Kansas adult facility. Carl was developmentally disabled and unable to communicate. Unfortunately, he could not tell his story.

“Carl died from peritonitis that resulted from a rupture in his small intestine as a result of a blunt trauma. He was the victim of an alleged abusive employee who worked in the facility at night. There was nobody else there to protect my brother.”

“If our family had not been able to pursue the truth by using documentation regarding the facility, we would have never known what really happened to Carl. As a result, the facility agreed to make positive changes that will help assure a safe environment for other vulnerable adults.”

The Kansas nursing home industry also wants you to believe that limiting inspection survey reports as evidence in court proceedings will reduce liability insurance premiums for nursing homes.

- Premiums in some states are increasing even for nursing homes that provide good quality care and have no history of claims against them.
- Many factors affect the cost and availability of nursing home liability insurance.
