# Cub Scout summer camps announced

The Coronado Area Council of Boy Scouts of America, which includes Colby youth, will sponsor Cub Scout Day Camps throughout the council during May and June.

Day Camps are one to three days in length. Day Camp runs from 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m.; activities are specific to each location, but generally will include archery, BB guns, sports games, ecology hikes, crafts and more.

All boys currently in grades one through four, registered with the Coronado Area Council can attend.

A trading post is available for camp souvenirs. Boys can attend with their Cub Scout Pack or with their Cub Scout Den or individually with a parent. The cost varies per camp and includes a t-shirt and patch if registered on time.

Webelos Scout Resident Camp (overnight camping) is a three-day/two night camp and is offered four times through the summer. Camp Hansen, located near Kirwin dates are July 6-8 and July 9-11. Camp Brown near Abilene dates are July 16-18 and July 23-25. Webelos

Scout Resident Camp is for boys going into grades four and five this fall. The cost is \$55 per youth and \$30 per adult.

Webelos Resident Camp activities include swimming, archery, BB guns, ecology study, hiking, campfires, a cookout meal, astronomy, sports games and more. Religious service will be provided. Webelos Activity Badges offered are: Aquanaut, Forester, Outdoorsman, Readyman and Scientist. All but one meal is served in the dining hall. The Kansas History theme has three vil-

lages that the boys stay in. A family picnic lunch is served on the last day.
