

Last Chautauqua film Sunday

The third and final film in the Kansas Humanities Council's Chautauqua "Bleeding Kansas" series will be presented at Pioneer Memorial Library on Sunday, April 25th, at 2 p.m. *Ride With the Devil* (1999) follows four people who are fighting for truth and justice amidst the turmoil of the American Civil War.

It takes us to a no man's land on the Missouri/Kansas border where a staunch loyalist (played by Skeet Ulrich), and immigrant's son (Tobey Maguire), a freed slave (Jeffrey Wright), and a young widow (Jewel) form an unlikely friendship as they learn how to survive in an uncertain time in a place without rules and redefine the meaning of bravery and honor.

Critics have given it a 4-star rating. Following the movie, there will be a short discussion led by Tom Prasch from Washburn University. This film is free and everyone is encouraged to attend. It is one more way for us all to get ready for the upcoming Chautauqua "Bleeding Kansas" tent show that will be here June 11th through the 15.
