The other false claim counts and one count of conspiracy are severity level nine nonperson felonies punishable by a sentence of five to 17 months in prison on each

Two of the conspiracy counts are severity level 10 nonperson felonies punishable by a sentence of five to 13 months in prison on each count. Each of the six felony charges also carries a fine of up to \$100,000, according to guidelines.

Assistant Attorney General Loren Snell will prosecute the case on behalf of the attorney general.
