

# Special Olympics flag group needs help

The Special Olympics Flag Committee is in need of volunteers for their fundraising efforts.

Each year over 200 flags are placed at businesses and residences to celebrate some of the legal holidays.

“As with all fundraising events volunteers are needed to continue this worthwhile project,” said

Chuck Dempewolf, one of committee members.

“The volunteers place the flags at the businesses or homes on a scheduled route of about 20-25 stops, taking approximately one hour to place the flags at sunrise and another hour at the end of the day to pick up the flags,” he said.

The routes can be adjusted to suit

the individuals volunteering, access to a pick up is helpful but not necessary.

“If you would like to help but cannot commit to the time, volunteers are also needed to prepare an area for the existing flags and any new flags by placing a tube in the ground for the flag and marking the curbs,” he said.

“This is a great project for individuals, families or organizations and requires only a small amount of time throughout the year.”

This project was started six years ago and has raised over \$40,000 in that time.

## Pets help people, but have needs too

MANHATTAN — People who have a pet usually fare better after a heart attack, said Kerri Parsons, Kansas State University Research and Extension specialist on aging. “A soothing relationship with a pet can help older adults reduce their stress or anxiety, lower their blood pressure and encourage heart-healthy exercise,” she said. The calming, health-promoting effect a pet can have on those around him or her has prompted some assisted living facilities and nursing homes to allow residents to bring smaller pets, including cats and dogs, Parsons said.

“Pets typically provide unconditional love, but caring for a pet does require time, money, and a commitment,” said Parsons, who consulted with Sanjay Kapil, associate professor at K-State’s College of Veterinary Medicine, about the responsibility of caring for a pet.

“Pets require an annual examination and vaccinations, and may require surgeries such as neutering or spaying,” Kapil said.

Dietary recommendations vary with breed and a pet’s age, but nutritionally-formulated pet food provides nutrients needed for a pet’s optimum health.

“Offering table scraps to a dog can shorten his or her life,” he said.

“A dog’s digestive system is not the same as ours. High-calorie or fat scraps add extra calories and also may be difficult for a dog to digest.”

“Foods that may be favorites of ours ^ chocolate, for example ^ can, be toxic to a dog,” Kapil said.

Pets can suffer from heart disease, diabetes and obesity, and some contagious diseases common to animals can be transferred to humans. Among them are fungal infections such as ring worm or toxoplasmosis; bacterial infections such as cat-scratch fever, salmonella, or tuberculosis, and viral diseases such as rabies, rotavirus and influenza.

Parasites also can be transferred from a pet to its owner or other humans who may come in contact with it, Kapil said.

Pet owners can promote health for their pet and themselves by washing their hands before and after touching their pet, and keeping pet dishes, feeding areas and bedding clean.

What should you do if your dog or cat is sneezing? Or suspect that your pet is not feeling well?

“Pets are members of the family. If a pet should experience a change in characteristic behavior or symptoms of an illness, such as a cough, sneeze, persistent itch or unex-

plained indigestion, consult a veterinarian before symptoms are allowed to exacerbate,” Kapil said.

Pets should not be given home remedies or drugs, such as cold medicine that is formulated for humans, he said.

“A pet is dependent on its owner for care,” said Kapil, who encouraged pet owners to provide for a pet’s care if the owner becomes ill.
