Colby K-18 vs. Phillipsburg for state crown

A big send-off scheduled for 3:30 Tuesday afternoon

All four of the West region qualifying teams dominated the first round of play Friday and Saturday at the State K-18 Baseball Tournament in Lucas.

Colby faced Beloit Blue, the number one seeded team in the tournament, on Saturday and won 10-6 with Kevin Lang pitching.

Sunday night, Colby scored a 10-5 triumph over a tough Plainville team, with both Levi Schlick and Mike Ackerman pitching. Colby only had a one-run lead going into the seventh inning of this game.

Batting first, Colby made sure they stretched their lead, scoring four more runs. With some great team play, Colby held the Plainville team scoreless in that inning, to qualify for the championship game.

Tuesday at 8 p.m., Colby will play the defending state champs, a very tough Phillipsburg team at Lucas.

Phillipsburg trounced both Belleville and Quinter with scores of 16-0 and 17-2, respectively in

their first two games, to qualify for the championship showdown.

Colby exhibited some of the best team play of the season in the first two games of this tournament. Colby brought to this tournament an impressive list of five tough and capable pitchers, two are still completely fresh and untapped. This fact, along with an undisclosed game plan for Phillipsburg, should prove Colby to be a serious contender for the state crown.

CU’s Calhoun transfers

BOULDER, Colo. (AP) — Former University of Colorado running back Brian Calhoun confirmed he has transferred and enrolled at Wisconsin.

His hometown of Oak Creek, Wis., is about two hours from his new school in Madison.

Calhoun led CU with 810 rushing yards and five touchdowns last season but said Saturday that he had difficulty adjusting after former

running backs coach Eric Bieniemy left for UCLA in 2002.

Bieniemy had recruited Calhoun to CU.

NCAA rules mandate that Calhoun sit out a football season at Wisconsin after transferring.

He can still compete in track and field for Wisconsin in the 2004-05 school year. Calhoun said he will compete in the 100 and 200 meters, and the long jump.
