# Trojans' Cormier living his dream

Two-time national wrestling champion Daniel Cormier is living his dream. The former Colby Community College wrestler is just weeks away from representing the United States at the Olympics in Athens.

Cormier, who won two NJCAA championships and led the Trojans to the incredible 1999 NJCAA team championship, will leave for Athens on Wednesday, Aug. 11.

Trojan head coach Steve Lampe will also be making the trip to Athens to support Cormier in his quest for a gold medal.

"I am very excited to make the trip," said Lampe. "I promised Daniel two years ago that I'd be there if he made the team. He is very healthy and improving at a very fast pace as he has defeated two of the world's top five in the past 10 months. He also has lost close overtime bouts to the number one- and two-ranked wrestlers so he's right on their tails."

Lampe just returned from the Olympic Training Center in Colorado Springs, Colo.

"The team has been undergoing very intensive training," said Lampe. "Sunday was their day off and the wrestlers were just content to stay in their rooms relaxing. The morale is high but not overconfident."

The freestyle wrestling event begins on Aug. 27. Cormier's weight

class will begin competition on Saturday, Aug. 28.

Cormier is currently ranked third in the world at 211.5 lbs. as published in this week's Sports Illustrated. He was a three-time Louisiana state prep champion and an All-State football player. After graduating from Colby Community College, Cormier continued his career at Oklahoma State University where he earned second in the 2001 championships while receiving a degree in sociology.

# Kansas City Chiefs' young kicker looking impressive

RIVER FALLS, Wis. (AP) — If Thursday's practice had been the deciding factor in the competition between Morten Andersen and Lawrence Tynes, Kansas City would have a new place kicker.

Tynes, the 26-year-old challenger to Andersen, who is nearing his 44th birthday, was straight and true on all three of his kicks.

Andersen, the league's No. 2 all-time scorer and veteran of 22 seasons, missed badly on his longest try, from 43 yards.

Andersen has beaten Tynes out for a place on the Chiefs' roster before. But the younger kicker is back after establishing himself as the top kicker in the Canadian Football League.

"It's maturity, growing up," Tynes said. "It's your job. You have to learn that. Being in Canada taught me a lot of things. You're playing for money. Sixteen games outdoors there is tougher than 16 games outdoors here."

Something else working in his favor: He's no longer intimidated by the legend of his rival.

"I'm competing against myself more than I am him," he said. "I think I got into that my first two years, looking at what he did, trying to match him kick-for-kick, which is not feasible when he's right down the middle every time."

"I'm trying to compete against myself. It's gone well so far." Coaches agree.
