

Three Colby Eagles crowned league wrestling champs

The Colby High Eagle wrestling team captured 4th place in Saturday's Northwest Kansas League Tournament at Atwood and in the process had three Eagles crowned league champions.

Senior Daniel Tibbles at 103 lbs. led the charge as he picked up 3 wins to earn his 1st place conference championship of his career. Tibbles improved his overall record to 27-1 on the season.

Cole Garcia junior at 140 lbs.,

won his 2nd consecutive league title be defeating Kelly Younkin of Oakley 4-2 in the championship match. Garcia improved to 26-1 on the year.

Colby sophomore Jared Flanagin also reached the championship round and defeated Gavin Smull of St. Francis 5-3 to earn the conference crown at 130 lbs.

Eagles lose on the road

The trip *to* Garden City was not as long as the trip *back* Tuesday night for both the Colby High varsity basketball teams.

The boys took it on the chin, 51-42, while the girls surrendered by the slimmest of margins, 58-56.

BOYS

Jared Dinkel and Matt Augustine teamed up to lead the charge for the Eagles with 18 and 14 points, respectively.

Fur Finley added 6 and Derek Elliott 4 — and that was it.

Garden City got 14 points from Ford and 12 from Cornett to share scoring honors.

Neither team dominated the boards with Colby pulling in 20 rebounds (9 offensive and 11 defensive) and Garden City 19 (7 offensive and 12 defensive).

The Eagles shot 46.6 percent from the field (18/37), 0 from 3-point range and 75.0 percent from the free throw line (6/8).

GIRLS

The Eagles trailed after one quarter of action, 10-8. But by half-time, the Colby bunch moved in front by a commanding 30-15 lead. And when the buzzer ended three periods of play, the Eagles were on top 41-33.

Enter: 4th quarter. The Eagles poked through 15 points which would lead most to believe that would nail the victory, but Garden City scored a whopping 25 points in the final frame to claim the win.

Emily Sloan was top point-maker for the Eagles and the game with 19. Brittany Kersenbrock scored 12 to also be in double figures. Jessica Stephens put through 7 points, Ashley Barnes 4, Lissa Mazanec 6 and Zanae Baird 8.

Kersenbrock was 2/3 from 3-point range.

For Garden City, R. Berry and L. Brown were top scorers with 14 and 13, respectively.

Colby had control of the board with 45 rebounds (14 offensively and 31 defensively) vs. 22 for the Garden City five (13 offensively and 9 defensively).

From the field Colby hit on 21/42 for 50.0 percent, 2/3 from 3-point range for 66.7 percent and 12/8 from the line for 66.7 percent.

For Garden City it was 22/68 for 37.9 percent, 3/11 from 3-point range for 27.3 percent and 11/25 from the charity stripe for 44.0 percent.
